Court Appearances

1. The Court will continue to provide directions to counsel and parties where the Court determines that an in-person hearing/appearance on an urgent matter is necessary. All other urgent hearings/appearances will be conducted via telephone or videoconference.
2. In accordance with the Special Measures Order revised on March 23, 2020, issued by the Chief Medical Officer of Health, any person attending an in-person hearing/appearance at the Court must ensure that they do not physically attend if they have travelled outside Newfoundland and Labrador in the preceding 14 days or are experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 or have had exposure to someone that has symptoms. If there are any concerns, the individual should contact the Court.
